

## MAJIMAJI MEMORIAL MUSEUM

Majimaji Memorial Museum is a branch of the National Museum of Tanzania located along Mahenge street, in Songea town. It was opened to the public in 2010. Formerly its ownership has been changing back and forth between the Regional Authority, the Elders Council and the Songea Municipality. Its uniqueness features include the mass grave of the hanged Majimaji warriors and the Kagera war askari monument.
